

GUIDELINES FOR CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

In accordance with CDC guidelines concerning best practices to reopen church and our children's ministry programs, these guidelines will be observed.



Practice Social Distancing

Whenever possible, stay 6 feet apart. There will be a limited number of children permitted in each area. Please register your child for Sunday mornings so that we can plan accordingly.

Masks

Face coverings are required to be worn by all volunteers and kids in Kid's Corner and Little Piney while inside the building. Children under the age of 2 are not required to wear face coverings.



Sanitization

All touched surfaces will be sanitized between services along with restrooms and changing stations. We will be rotating toys between services for cleaning purposes. We will not be sharing supplies. All children will have their own supplies.

Healthy Hygiene

Children should wash their hands or use hand sanitizer before entering any ministry area, after coughing or sneezing, after using the restroom, and after being outside. There will be hand sanitizer available throughout the buildings.




Temperature Checks and Illness policy

All volunteers and children will have their temperatures checked upon entry to any children's ministry area. Adults or children with a temperature of 100 degrees or higher will be asked to watch the online service at home.

Contactless Check-in

All children can be checked in prior to entry via the Church Center app. All other children will be checked in by a volunteer upon entry.
